Sub: Additional information/classifications regarding Tariff Petition for Truing-up for FY 2018-19, Annual Performance Review for FY 2019-20 and Aggregate Revenue Requirement and SLDC operating charges for FY 2020-21 for SLDC.

Ref: (i) **BERC letter no BERC Case No.** – **33/2019-1359 dated 26.11.2019.**. Sir.

With reference to the above, please find enclosed herewith details of following information/ clarifications:-

- 1. Status/Progress of Implementation of SAMAST is attached as **Annexure-I** and the schedule completion date and tentative date of capitalization is 05th June 2020.
- 2. Copy of contract appointing the agency for supply of software/hardware/equipment etc. and annual maintenance of SAMAST is enclosed as **Annexure II**.
- 3. As per SAMAST guidelines, funding for implementation of SAMAST in the state of Bihar was to be done with the help of PSDF grant. Accordingly, SLDC/BSPTCL proposed the fund for SAMAST from PSDF grant in SLDC Business Plan and Multiyear Tariff petition filed before Hon'ble BERC for FY 2019-20 to FY 2021-22.

Hon'ble BERC directed via order dated 09.04.2019 that,

"Implementation of SAMAST is in the interest of SLDC and many states have already launched it. It is upto the SLDC and BSPTCL to take a call on the arrangement of funds for timely implementation of the scheme. There is already a considerable delay in

implementation of SAMAST and any further delay in Bihar would not be in the interest of the State".

Accordingly, BSPTCL and SLDC have decided to use Internal Resource Fund (IRF) as per direction of Hon'ble BERC order dated 09.04.2019 for Balance Work of SAMAST (Engagement of Consultant/Solution provider for implementation etc.) to avoid further delay and to ensure timely completion of SAMAST recommendations and the same was communicated to Hon'ble BERC vide letter no. 216 dated 10.06.2019.

- 4. Source of IRF for meeting the expenditure of SAMAST is IRF (Internal Resource Fund) of BSPTCL as mentioned in the above reply.
- Hon'ble Commission have accorded approval in principle of submitted DPR vide order dated 05.01.2018. SLDC has now submitted the revised cost of SAMAST project through its petition for approval of Hon'ble Commission.

6. The following table shows the actual employee expense for FY 2017-18 and FY 2018-19:-

The increase in employee expanse is on account of

- I. Addition of employee.
- II. 7th pay commission Arrear paid of amount 0.16 crore and its corresponding impact on salary of employee.
- III. Annual increment of 3% of basis during the year.
- 7. SAMAST phase-I (Scheduling, Accounting, Open Access and Settlement Modules) was go-live in February, 2018. Though, the project was implemented by outside agency, additional manpower was required for smoothly handling the system for Scheduling, Accounting and Settlement Modules and to make it function. Accordingly, there was an increase in the employee cost for FY 2018-19. Further, as per the directives of the Hon'ble Commission, strengthening of SLDC is going on through

various activities, which affected the employee cost for FY 2018-19, as per Pradhan Committee report.

8. Presently, SAMAST phase-I is functional. In FY 2019-20 out of 12 modules in SAMAST project, modules like Accounting through ABT meter of Intra-state entities, Scheduling (for MTPS & BTPS), Open Access (only 03 nos. STOA) and Deviation Settlement (only for Railway) are functional. For further development and management, SLDC has proposed increase in the manpower to 54 Nos. as compared to 41 Nos. of employee during FY 2018-19. In FY 2020-21, 15-20 additional employees including IT wing will be required for handling of SAMAST work. Accordingly, SLDC has proposed increase in manpower to 68 Nos. as compared to 54 Nos. of employee during FY 2019-20.

SLDC has already proposed to HR & Admin. Department for posting/deputing of additional requirement of manpower in order to carry out the works of SLDC.
